### September Technical Presentation – Wireless Building Automation Systems

This month's technical presentation will be presented by Mr. Kwan Haughton, Regional Account Manager with Johnson Controls Inc. Mr. Haughton will be discussing Wireless BAS Systems Using Zigbee.
