November Technical Presentation – Filtration & LEED Requirements

This month the Evansville Chapter of ASHRAE is happy to have Mr. Ron Long with AAF Int'l present to us the advances in filtration for HVAC systems.

Mr. Long is a graduate of the University of Kentucky with a Bachelors degree in Mechanical Engineering. He joined AAF International (American Air Filter) in 1987 as a Project Engineer and has held several positions with AAF since then. Currently he is a Product Manager responsible for the HVAC filters used in Commercial, Industrial and Institutional applications.

Ron will be discussing higher efficiency filters available to meet the LEED requirement of a minimum of MERV 13. He will also discuss Gas Phase products available for use in HVAC systems for the control of odors and other molecular contaminants.
